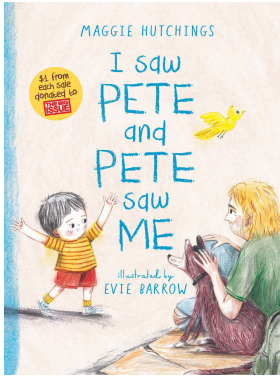

Create your own 'sunshine feelings' chalk painting

What you need:

- Paper
- Pencil
- Paint containers or recycled egg carton
- Food dye
- Corn starch
- Water

1. Using a pencil and scrap paper, plan out your chalk painting. Think about what images might brighten someone else's day.
2. Create your homemade chalk paint by mixing together $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of corn starch with $\frac{2}{3}$ cup of water. Mix until the corn starch dissolves. Divide your mixture into small containers (a recycled egg carton works well!) and add drops of food dye to make different colours.
3. Find a driveway, footpath or other flat concrete surface to do your painting on. If you can't find a concrete surface you could do your painting on paper and display it somewhere for others to see.
4. Complete your painting using your plan as a guide, you might like to add a happy message for someone else to read.
